- Joined as the second engineer on a new commerce team focused on subscription growth and retention.
 - Led the Frontend and backend implementation of four new subscription plans in our checkout flow and redesigned our pricing page to reflect the updated pricing models.
 - Worked as a project lead to introduce a new pricing model for Latin American markets, achieving an 11% lift in paid subscriptions in Mexico and Brazil.
- Drove an initiative to allow users to upgrade their subscriptions to yearly billing cycles or higher tiers.
 - Engineered a new upgrade endpoint, collaborating with the billing team for rigorous testing and successful implementation.
 - Created a manage plan page for comprehensive subscription control, leading to a 3% increase in yearly subscriptions.
 - Developed an upgrade flow on the pricing page, enabling direct user upgrades with credit and coupon integration.
 - Established a new retention metric for upgrades, facilitating marketing campaigns to boost yearly plan upgrades.
- Led multiple team initiatives to improve processes, developer velocity and accessibility.
 - Partnered with EM and Director to draft a comprehensive team-level on-call proposal, defining responsibilities and SLAs.
 - Established a Product/Engineering working agreement, enhancing processes for cross-functional team collaboration.
 - Transitioned client-side components to utilize Next.js server-side rendering, improving FCP.
 - Conducted an accessibility audit for the checkout flow, implementing fixes to achieve a 96% Lighthouse score.

- Member of the web UI team where we drove the component library that powered Twitter.com
 - Partnered with stakeholders to port and integrate new components into the component library.
 - Improved developer velocity by 30% by building an internal tool similar to React-Docgen for automated prop documentation.
 - Built a slackbot to automatically triage incoming bug reports, feature requests and questions that would get added to our on-call backlog.
- Led a framework upgrade for Twitter.com and seven adjacent codebases from React Native Web .16 to .18
 - Collaborated with external teams to ensure a bug-free launch.
 - Fixed accessibility, styling, and language reading direction issues, increasing accessibility coverage by 4%.
- Driver of a navigation header bar redesign for Twitter.com.
 - Aligned web UI with mobile clients by adding a subtle blur animation to headers, enhancing user experience.
 - Reduced visual fatigue and increased tweet and advertisement viewing space for web users by 10%.
